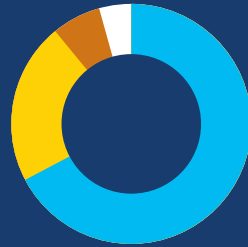

FY2022 SUPPORT FOR THE STLCC FOUNDATION

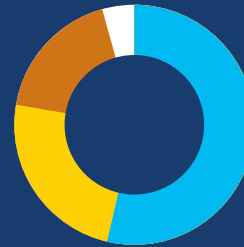


Foundation Donors

STLCC’s annual **IMPACT** on St. Louis is **\$2 billion**



For every **\$1 INVESTED** into their STLCC education, students gain **\$4.70** increase in future income over their working careers. Taxpayers gain \$2.80 in added tax revenue and public sector savings. Society gains \$10.80 in added state revenue and social savings.
