# **Patient Care Technician Training**

**Ready to start your career in healthcare?** St. Louis Community College and Barnes-Jewish Hospital are seeking qualified individuals to attend training to work as full-time Patient Care Technicians (PCTs). This 11-week accelerated training program combines classroom instruction, hands-on skill labs and on-the-job training in a clinical practice. The training satisfies the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services requirements for Unlicensed Assistive Personnel.



### **Program Highlights:**

- Individuals selected for the program will be hired as PCTs during training. Starting wage is \$17.50 per hour.
- Tuition funding is provided by BJC HealthCare. Minimum 1year employment commitment to assigned hospital required upon completion.

# **Current Eligibility:**

Enrollment for the PCT program is selective. Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements to be selected.

## Before you apply you must:

- · Be 18+ years old.
- · Have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Meet the transfer eligibility requirements if you're a current BJC HealthCare employee.
- · Be available to work nights, weekends, and holidays.

# After you apply with BJC you will be required to:

- · Complete a screening interview with a BJC Talent Advisor.
- · Attend BJC and SSM Health Information Session
- Complete interviews and be selected by BJC HealthCare staff.
- · Pass a criminal background check, drug screen panel, and proof of immunizations or titers.
