

## December 2020 Early High School Graduate Enrollment Steps

- **Apply for financial aid as soon as possible at: [fafsa.ed.gov](https://fafsa.ed.gov).**
    - Complete the 2020-2021 FAFSA application.
    - STLCC's Federal School Code: 002469.
    - Financial Aid applicants (including Pell and A+) must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit all required financial aid documents to their campus Financial Aid office.

  - **Apply for admission at: [stlcc.edu/apply](https://stlcc.edu/apply).**
    - Choose Application Type: First-Time College.
    - Select Admission Term: Credit Spring 2021.
    - Enter Date of HS Graduation of: December 31, 2020.

  - **Receive STLCC admissions acceptance letter, get connected & submit required documents.**
    - Use your Student A Number (located on your admissions acceptance letter) and visit [stlcc.edu/getconnected](https://stlcc.edu/getconnected) to get your MySTLCC ID, student email and Navigate account.
    - Submit required documents to [STLCC-Registrar's office](#)
    - **Early HS Graduate Form:** Must be prepared and signed by a school official (principal, counselor, or registrar), and must identify a graduation date that is before January 19, 2021.
    - **Final, official high school transcript with graduation date (and A+ seal if applicable):** must be received by the Registrar's office by Monday, Jan. 11, 2021.
  
  - **Register for classes.**
    - [Complete Archer Preview](#) - First-time college students must complete [Archer Orientation](#). You will start this process by viewing an [orientation video](#) that provides important information about STLCC.
    - [Meet with an Advisor and register for classes](#) – Meet one-on-one with a professional advisor to review your current high school transcript and ACT scores if you have them, and guide your placement for English, math and reading courses. Your advisor will also work with you to explore programs of study and select the appropriate classes for your educational goals.
