

Early High School Graduate Enrollment Steps

Apply for financial aid as soon as possible at: fafsa.ed.gov

- STLCC's Federal School Code: 002469.
- Financial Aid applicants (including Pell and A+) must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and submit all required financial aid documents to their campus Financial Aid office.

- Choose Application Type: First-Time College.

- Enter Date of HS Graduation of: December 31, 2019.

- **Early HS Graduate Form:** Must be prepared and signed by a school official (principal, counselor, or registrar), and must identify a graduation date that is before January 21, 2020.
- **Final, official high school transcript with graduation date (and A+ seal if applicable):** must be received by the Registrar's office by Friday, Jan. 10, 2020.
