


ELIGIBLE CITIZEN & NON-CITIZEN AFFIDAVIT

The Department of Education was unable to match your citizen or eligible non-citizen of the United States with either the Social Security Administration or the Department of Homeland Security. As a result, you will need to submit appropriate documentation verifying your citizenship.

U.S. Citizen – I am a U.S. citizen, and am providing a copy of one of the following:

- □ A Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561)
- □ A Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570)
- □ Birth Certificate showing the student was born in the U.S. which includes Puerto Rico
- U.S. Passport or wallet-sized passport card-(Limited passports are not acceptable)
- □ Eligible Non-Citizen I am an eligible non-citizen, and I am providing a copy of one of the following:
 - □ U.S. Permanent Resident Card/Resident Alien Card (I-551) or Alien Registration Receipt Card (I-151)
 - Arrival/Departure Record (I-94) with one of the following stamps:
 - Refugee
 - Persons granted asylum
 - Persons Paroled into the U.S. for at least one year
 - Cuban-Haitian entrants
 - Victims of human trafficking
 - Battered immigrants-qualified aliens

If you have any of the following statuses you are *ineligible* to receive federal student aid:

- Non-immigrant visa: student, work, visitors and foreign government officials
- Employment only authorization documents
- Temporary Resident Card
- Notice of Approval to Apply for Permanent Residence
