Occupational Therapy Assistant PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Student must have **SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED ALL REQUIREMENTS** listed below **PRIOR TO APPLYING** to the Occupational Therapy Assistant Program.

_____1 **APPLICATION FORM:** FOR ADMISSION TO THE COLLEGE, apply online at STLCC.edu.

_____2 **DEGREE SEEKING STATUS**

____A. **Official College Transcripts** — An official transcript from **each** college attended must be sent directly from the college attended to **STLCC-Registrar's Office, 5600 Oakland Avenue, St. Louis, 63110** or email: csr@stlcc.edu. ____B. **High School Transcript or GED**—required only for students with fewer than 15 hours of college level work or those who have satisfied the science requirements in high school. **Current high school students must submit a final high school transcript before applying to the OTA Program.**

_____3 **MINIMUM CUMULATIVE GPA** of 2.5 in high school or for 15 hours (minimum) of college work. **Students with fewer than 15 hours of college credit must have both a 2.5 GPA in high school and 2.5 GPA in college.**

- **GED Applicants:** must have 15 hours of **(100 level)** college credits with a 2.5 GPA.

- **STLCC students with at least 15 college level credits with a 2.5 GPA:** will have met this requirement, regardless of the GPA at other colleges.

- **College transfer students with fewer than 15 STLCC credits:** must have a cumulative 2.5 GPA in college level credits earned at all colleges attended.

NOTE: Developmental courses (numbered below 100) will **NOT** be counted toward the 15 hours of collegework and will **NOT** be included in the GPA for admission to the program.

_____4 **READING: COMPLETE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING TO MEET THE READING PREREQUISITE**

• Composite ACT score of 21 or higher **OR** SAT verbal score of 500 or higher (**within the last 3 years**)

• Accuplacer (Next Gen) score of 263 or higher **OR** Accuplacer (Classic) score of 86 or higher **OR** Compass score of 91 or higher on the Reading Portion (**within the last 3 years**)

• Completion of RDG 100 Introduction to College Reading with a "C" or higher

• Completion of Bachelor degree or higher.

_____5 **ENGLISH: COMPLETE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING TO MEET THE ENGLISH PREREQUISITE**

• Composite ACT score of 21 or higher **OR** SAT verbal score of 500 or higher (**within the last 3 years**)

• Accuplacer (Next Gen) score of 250 or higher **OR** Accuplacer (Classic) score of 83 or higher **OR** Compass score of 70 or higher on the Writing Skills Portion (**within the last 3 years**)

• Completion of ENG 030 Foundations of College Writing **OR** ENG 070 Academic English for Non-native Speakers III with a "C" or higher

_____6 **MATH: COMPLETE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING TO MEET THE MATH PREREQUISITE**

• Math ACT score of 22 or higher **OR** SAT math score of 580 or higher (**within the last 3 years**)

• Place into MTH: 140 Intermediate Algebra or higher on the Accuplacer (Next Gen or Classic) **OR** Compass (**within the last 3 years**)

• Completion of MTH 050 Mathematical Literacy or higher level math with a "C" or higher

_____7 **SCIENCE REQUIRMENT:** (*beginning August 1, 2020*)

• BIO 207 Anatomy and Physiology I: completion with a grade of "C" or higher **within the last 5 years**

_____8 **PSYCHOLOGY REQUIREMENT:** (*beginning August 1, 2020*)

• PSY 200 General Psychology: completion with a grade of "C" or higher **within the last 5 years**

_____9 **When the above criteria have been met, students must submit a separate OTA Program application signed by an advisor, and returned to the OTA office at cchambers@stlcc.edu on the Meramec campus.**
