

# Patient Care Technician Training

June 2024 with Barnes-Jewish Hospital



**Ready to start your career in healthcare?** St. Louis Community College and Barnes-Jewish Hospital are seeking qualified individuals to attend training to work as full-time Patient Care Technicians (PCTs). This 11-week accelerated training program combines classroom instruction, hands-on skill labs and on-the-job training in a clinical practice. The training satisfies the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services requirements for Unlicensed Assistive Personnel.



## Program Highlights:

- Individuals selected for the program will be hired as PCTs during training. Starting wage is \$17.50 per hour.
- Tuition funding is provided by BJC HealthCare. Minimum 1-year employment commitment to assigned hospital required upon completion.

## Training Schedule:

**June 3 – August 16, 2024**

11-week full-time training at STLCC and Barnes-Jewish Hospital. 36 hours weekly.

**Hybrid Didactic Training** | 7 weeks at STLCC's William J. Harrison Education Center, 3140 Cass Ave, St. Louis, MO 63106

- **Classroom/Lab:** Mon/Wed from 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Tues/Thurs from 8 a.m.-1 p.m., and Fri from 8 a.m.-noon
- **Online Coursework:** 10+ hours weekly

**Clinical Practice** | 4 weeks at Barnes-Jewish Hospital campus

- Three 12-hour shifts weekly; may include weekends

## Current Eligibility:

Enrollment for the PCT program is selective. Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements to be selected.

## Before you apply you must:

- Be 18+ years old.
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Meet the transfer eligibility requirements if you're a current BJC HealthCare employee.
- Be available to work nights, weekends, and holidays.

## After you apply with BJC you will be required to:

- Complete a screening interview with a BJC Talent Advisor.
- Attend BJC and SSM Health Information Session
- Complete interviews and be selected by BJC HealthCare staff.
- Pass a criminal background check, drug screen panel, and proof of immunizations or titers.
