Deadline for resume submission is November 1, 2024. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Students will be emailed information session dates and are encouraged to bring parents/guardians to the session.
 Information session attendance is mandatory. If you are under the age of 18, a parent or guardian must attend the information session with you.
- 3. Attend Measurement/Layout training and pass assessment. This will be scheduled in conjunction with the information session.
- 4. Submit a signed letter of recommendation from a faculty member at your high school.
 - This letter must state the following:
 - No risk of the student not graduating
 - Student has no disciplinary/attendance issues
 - The school recognizes the student as a good candidate for the training.
