GENERAL INFORMATION

Please read all information thoroughly.
Be sure to note the withdrawal and refund policy and dates for processing requests.

For students age 12 to 16 as of June 1, 2024.

Online registration begins March 6 at 8:30 a.m. Payment for classes is due at time of registration. A 2.75% fee will be added for debit/credit card processing.

Where and when do classes meet?

Classes meet June 24-27, in the Health Sciences building on the Forest Park campus, located at 5600 Oakland Avenue, St. Louis, MO, 63110. Check-in information will be included in the information letter sent a couple of weeks before the program begins.

Health Guidelines

All individuals who are on the STLCC campuses must abide by all health and safety guidelines set forth by government agencies and the College.

What about lunch?

Please send a sack lunch with your child. A lunch break will be provided between the morning and afternoon sessions. Students must remain with their class during lunch. Please consider that students must carry their lunches with them throughout the day; pack accordingly. Because lunches are being brought from home, we cannot guarantee an allergy-free environment. A peanut-free table will be available.

What should my child bring each day?

All students should bring a water bottle and two snacks each day. Please limit personal items and make sure all bags, water bottles, lunch boxes and outerwear are labeled with your child's name. A Lost and Found is located at the Information Table.

What if I need to withdraw my child? Will I receive a refund?

Students who register and must later withdraw must do so in writing. Email withdrawal requests to cedropbox@stlcc.edu. Any refund given will be based upon the date of receipt of written withdrawal by the Continuing Education office. You will receive a full refund if the withdrawal is on or before May 31, 2024. No refunds will be permitted after this date unless the College has canceled the program.

Can you tell me more about the Xploration - Healthcare shirts?

Every child registered for Xploration-Healthcare receives a shirt the first day of the program. Shirt size will be collected in a packet sent after registration. Students are encouraged, but not required, to wear their shirts during the program.

Cancellation Policy

The College reserves the right to cancel the classes if minimum enrollment is not met. Students will be notified no later June 3, 2024 and refunds will be issued.

How will my child know their schedule?

On the first day of classes, students will be issued a name tag with their complete schedule printed on it. New name tags will be issued each day. Staff will guide youth between classes.

Why must they wear their name tag each day?

It is critical that your youth wear their name tag daily during the program. This is our only way of identifying your youth in an emergency and in assisting your youth to the appropriate classes.

What about check-in and check-out each day?

All participants who are enrolled in programs through St. Louis Community College Continuing Education youth classes must be accompanied to the check-in area and signed in at the beginning of each day. Only contacts listed on your welcome forms are considered approved for pick-up and must provide a photo ID each day when signing students out. Students will not be released until the stated times.

What are the program requirements and expectations?

Forms, payment, media release, liability waiver, and code of conduct must be completed prior to your youth's participation in the program. Appropriate behavior is expected. Students must adhere to the Rules and Code of Conduct. An online link to the forms will be sent prior to the start of the program. At the time of registration, please ensure you provide an active email address that you check on a regular basis.

Special Accommodations

If your student requires an accommodation for a disability in order to participate in any program or activity, please contact the Access Office at stlcc.edu/disability at the time of registration for consideration of your request. The College recommends submitting the application as early as possible to allow time to make any necessary arrangements.
